Guidelines for Submission of Paper

- Authors can submit their full papers through an email attachment to: icrlconf.2024@gmail.com
- The main title should be followed by name, affiliation, and address of the author(s) with e-mail
- The paper should be in MS Word format, font: Times New Roman, Size: 12, space: 1.5 lines, paper size: A4, Keyword: 2-5 words, Paper length: 3-8 pages
- All references should be presented according to the APA Style
- The paper should be sent along with the declaration letter stating that the work is the original and not presented/published anywhere else.
- The paper should contain the names of the authors, Email ID, and Contact numbers


